

# **PULL the ROCK - Antique Tractor Pull, Granite Ia.**

## **Friday July 19, 2024 at 4:00 p.m. (NEW start time)**

### **STOCK (if you have to ask if something is allowed, you're likely not in this class)**

- No cut tires, tire limits apply (see below).
- 3 mph speed limit, MAX RPM is 10% over high idles.
- Stock seat, fuel tank, stock hitch and drawbar. Max height on hitch is 18", Clevis provided.

### **CLASS 1 1959 & older (3500 lb – 7500 lb)**

- No cut tires, tire limits apply (see below).
- 3.5 MPH speed limit, MAX RPM max of 20% over high idle.

### **CLASS 2 1959 & older (3500 lb – 6500 lb)**

- 5 MPH.
- RPM max of 20% over high idle.
- Cut tires allowed, Max tire size for all classes is 18.4 X 38 on any rim width.
- No shifting of T/A.

### **CLASS 3 1959 & older (4000 lb thru 6500 lb)**

- 500 RPM over manufacture high idle.

### **General rules apply:**

- Hook fees are \$25.00 per hook, maximum of **three (3)** hooks per tractor total (no class jumping, example pulling stock and class 1 not allowed). Minimum of 3 hooks per class to do a payout.
- NO radial tires in any class.
- NO shifting of TA's for stock, class 1 and 2. **Allowed for class 3 only.**
- Drawbar must be stationary with a 3" hole and no more than 1" of material left at the rear of the hole. **20" height for classes 1-3 (stock is 18" plus clevis).** No closer than 18" from the center of the rear axle. Fast hitches must be pinned solid and locked from movement.
- Weights cannot be more than 11 feet from the center of the rear axle. Rear weights must not extend beyond the rear tires.
- Any part falling off the tractor after being hooked and until the tractor is unhooked will result in disqualification.
- No turbos allowed. Naturally aspirated only, no LP or nitrous oxide injection. Blowers allowed on Detroit diesels. No curved exhaust pipes.
- No homemade intake or exhaust manifolds. Ag type carburetor only. (applies to stock, class 1 & 2.
- Tractors must have the same number of cylinders as equipped from the factory.
- Fuel allowed is gasoline, diesel fuel LP gas E85/99.
- Throttles must have a positive stop and a working governor.
- All tractors subject to RPM check at any time.
- All decisions made by track officials are final.
- Tip bars required in class 2 and 3. Kill switches required for class 3.
- Protests must be made while tractor is hooked to the skid. Protests must be made by another puller in the same class.
- 100 lb weight allowed (example: pulling 5500 lbs, your max weight is 5600 lbs). NO exceptions.

### **Stock and Class 1 - No cut tires with max sizes applied per weight classes:**

- 210 sq in tire size max for classes thru 5500 lb 14.9 X 38
- 255 sq in tire size max for 6000 lb and 6500 lb 16.9 X 38
- 320 sq in tire size max for classes 7500 lb 18.4 X 38
